- Consider key features of quality outdoor play provision.
- Consider the role of the adult in supporting children's play and exploration.
- Examine ways in which adults can support and extend children's learning in how they plan, organise and resource challenging environments which encourage children's self directed play.
- Address some of the challenges of bringing the outdoors in.
